## Baby Travel Packing Checklist

### BABY-SPECIFIC ITEMS

Take along a few key items baby is familiar with, like their blankie (of course!) and their favorite stuffed toy or a bath toy they love. There is nothing like familiarity and sense of routine to a baby/toddler, however remember not to weigh yourself down with all the toys in the toy-box!

<input type="checkbox"/> Baby backpack or carrying bag (backpacks are great as you are hands-free and not lop-sided)	<input type="checkbox"/> Car Seat w base (you can skip this and bring baby carrier only – rent a car seat/stroller where you are headed)
<input type="checkbox"/> Formula or milk, if you are not breast-feeding	<input type="checkbox"/> Front Carrier or Sling
<input type="checkbox"/> Baby food/Baby Cereal (or buy at destination)	<input type="checkbox"/> Plastic bags or a Diaper Bag Dispenser with Bags
<input type="checkbox"/> Eating utensils (to avoid 'disposable' items, rinse in bathroom and bring a kitchen towel cut in strips, to wrap cutlery for washing/re-use later)	<input type="checkbox"/> Hand wipes/small bottle of disinfecting hand gel, baby wash, and baby lotion
<input type="checkbox"/> Bottles & Nipples	<input type="checkbox"/> Tissues
<input type="checkbox"/> Sippy Cups	<input type="checkbox"/> Energy-boosting snacks for mom/dad to munch on
<input type="checkbox"/> Teething Crackers / 'Baby-friendly' Snacks	<input type="checkbox"/> Night light
<input type="checkbox"/> Baby Toothbrush and Toothpaste	<input type="checkbox"/> Simple first-aid travel kit
<input type="checkbox"/> Shampoo, body wash, powder, butt cream (baby toiletries)	<input type="checkbox"/> Baby pain reliever and supplies for treating minor injuries or teething (pack in plastic sealable bag to prevent leaks)
<input type="checkbox"/> Grooming kit (with baby nail clippers and hairbrush)	<input type="checkbox"/> Baby pain reliever and supplies for treating minor injuries or teething (pack in plastic sealable bag to prevent leaks)
<input type="checkbox"/> Blankies (bring a few: to lay baby on, cover baby, cover self, protect clothes from messy burps, shade baby, and more)	<input type="checkbox"/> "Child-Proofing" Safety Items such as: Electric plug covers, corner covers. Some hardware stores sell all-in-one kits
<input type="checkbox"/> Pacifier (if baby using one)	<input type="checkbox"/> Baby (video) monitor
<input type="checkbox"/> Toys and best stuffed animals (choose 6 maximum!), Markers, Drawing Paper	<input type="checkbox"/> Babyfood steamer/processor, if necessary (we use 'Beaba')
<input type="checkbox"/> Diapers (1 for each 3 hrs in transit, plus extras in case of delays)	<input type="checkbox"/> Camera, battery charger, and an extra memory card
<input type="checkbox"/> Swim Diapers and/or Baby's Swimsuit	<input type="checkbox"/> Phone number of baby's healthcare provider in case you have questions while on the road
<input type="checkbox"/> Pad to put under baby during diaper changes	<input type="checkbox"/> Bubbles blower!
<input type="checkbox"/> Inflatable baby bathtub	<input type="checkbox"/> Flash Cards or Other Compact / Educational Activity
<input type="checkbox"/> Bath Toys	<input type="checkbox"/> Crib bedding
<input type="checkbox"/> Sun hats	<input type="checkbox"/> Collapsible Stroller
<input type="checkbox"/> 1-2 outfits per day (if not planning on doing laundry) – and of course, rotating	<input type="checkbox"/> Bibs
<input type="checkbox"/> Sweater(s)	<input type="checkbox"/> Drool cloth(s)
<input type="checkbox"/> Socks	<input type="checkbox"/> Diaper Cream
<input type="checkbox"/> Shoes/Sandals	<input type="checkbox"/> Wipes
<input type="checkbox"/> Travel crib/cot/play yard	<input type="checkbox"/> Two fresh pillow cases

### MONEY & DOCUMENTS

<input type="checkbox"/> Cash /credit cards/debit/ATM cards	<input type="checkbox"/> Vaccination documents if needed (baby's yellow health record card)
<input type="checkbox"/> Passports	<input type="checkbox"/> Trip itinerary /Airplane tickets, or confirmation number for e-ticket
<input type="checkbox"/> Drivers' license	<input type="checkbox"/> Hotel and/or car reservation numbers
<input type="checkbox"/> Consent letter from non-traveling parent if traveling solo	<input type="checkbox"/> Bank account numbers
<input type="checkbox"/> Photocopies of passport & drivers' license – packed separately, in case ID is lost or stolen	<input type="checkbox"/> Cheques/checks and security device (for one of my bank accounts, can only make transfers using a security device! good thing I remembered to pack it!)
<input type="checkbox"/> Get a travel plan for cell phone?	<input type="checkbox"/> Health & travel insurance documents
<input type="checkbox"/> Other Photo ID	<input type="checkbox"/> Business Cards

## TOILETRIES

<input type="checkbox"/> Toothpaste, toothbrushes, dental floss	<input type="checkbox"/> Shampoo, conditioner, hair products
<input type="checkbox"/> Brush & comb	<input type="checkbox"/> Shaving gear
<input type="checkbox"/> Glasses and/or Contact lens accessories	<input type="checkbox"/> Sunglasses
<input type="checkbox"/> Skin cream	<input type="checkbox"/> Make-up and Make-up Remover
<input type="checkbox"/> Nail clippers	<input type="checkbox"/> Tweezers
<input type="checkbox"/> Ear plugs	<input type="checkbox"/> Insect repellent
<input type="checkbox"/> Afterbite, for insect bites	<input type="checkbox"/> Sun block 2
<input type="checkbox"/> health care	<input type="checkbox"/> Band-aids (these may already be in your first-aid kit)
<input type="checkbox"/> Topical antibiotic ointment	<input type="checkbox"/> Disinfecting liquid like hydrogen peroxide or alcohol
<input type="checkbox"/> Cotton swabs	<input type="checkbox"/> Pain relief tablets
<input type="checkbox"/> Baby pain/fever reliever	<input type="checkbox"/> Oral rehydration liquid or sachets
<input type="checkbox"/> Allergy medicine	<input type="checkbox"/> Feminine hygiene products
<input type="checkbox"/> Prescription medicines	<input type="checkbox"/> Mommy/Daddy Vitamins or Supplements

## MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

<input type="checkbox"/> Earplugs + earplugs for <b>everyone</b> around you on the flight! (when baby is just not happy, give them to your closest neighbors with a smile and gentle shoulders shrug 😊)	<input type="checkbox"/> Smartphone & charger
<input type="checkbox"/> Camera and batteries	<input type="checkbox"/> Chargers (for camera, laptop, mobile phone, tablet)
<input type="checkbox"/> International plug	<input type="checkbox"/> Tablet/Laptop/headphone
<input type="checkbox"/> Pen & Paper	<input type="checkbox"/> Assorted plastic bags
<input type="checkbox"/> Assorted plastic containers	<input type="checkbox"/> Mini Flashlight & batteries (check airlines policies for batteries – should be okay if checked in)
<input type="checkbox"/> Needle and thread	<input type="checkbox"/> Travel alarm clock (you have a baby, who needs an alarm clock?!)
<input type="checkbox"/> Small amount of dish and/or laundry soap	<input type="checkbox"/> Waterproof sheet
<input type="checkbox"/> Beach toys and water wings for baby	<input type="checkbox"/> Water goggles
<input type="checkbox"/> Dish soap, dish sponge and dishwashing gloves (you'd be amazed how much washing of baby food and drink items you could wash/rinse when on the go!)	<input type="checkbox"/> Your housekeys, car keys / keychain (put these in a luggage pocket you can access easily when you arrive home!)
